Items:

- 1901
Inland steel accepted an offer of 50 acres of free land in east Chicago on which the steel company built a \$1 million plant.
- 1908
First ore boat unloading at U.S. Steel's Gary Works, making the beginning of steel production there.
- 1909
The Cobe Cup race was held in Lake County. The course was 23.6 miles and ran through Crown Point, Cedar Lake, Lowell.
- 1914
A train wreck occurred on the train tracks in Lowell. Part of the wreckage is buried underground at what is now Liberty Park.
- 1816
Indiana becomes the 19th state of the union.
